The School of Arts education in fine arts, dancing, music and theatre is voluntary. It takes place after school, but sometimes even during school hours. We offer both private lessons and group education depending on subject and course. We offer adapted education for children and young people with functional disorders.

Who Can Apply?

Our education is there for everyone who lives in the municipality of Örebro, from the year you are nine years old. We also offer children's dance from the age of four and choir from age seven. One can participate in activities at the School of Arts up to the year when you turn 19, or when you finish upper secondary school.

Fees and Instrument Hire

Our voluntary education is subject to a fee.

Orchestral instruments (violin, cello, clarinet, oboe, trumpet etc.) can be hired from the School of Arts.
